Senator Cash asked:

With reference to the various women's leadership programs that have been previously funded and the programs included in the 2010-2011 budget:

- a. Please advise particulars of the amount of the grant in respect of each current program and the organisation to which it was paid, the project completion date?
- b. Please provide details of the various women's leadership programs funded for each of the financial years ended 2007, 2008, 2009, 2010 and the respective completion dates?
- c. Were any projects not completed by the original completion date and if so why, and what action was taken in respect to the failure of the organisation to comply with the agreed completion date.
- d. What governance procedures are in place to ensure the funding provided for a particular organisation is used for the purpose of the grant?
- e. How many women participated in the leadership programs that you funded in the past financial year?

Answer:

- a. Details of the grants provided under the Women's Leadership and Development Program (WLDP) 2007-08, 2008-09 and 2009-10 are at Attachment A.

- c. All projects are complete.
- d. As part of their funding agreement requirements, all funding recipients are required to provide a final project evaluation report and an independently audited acquittal accounting for expenditure of the grant.

For grants where this information is required to be reported, such as programs run by UNIFEM and Girl Guides Australia, final reports are not yet due.
