Senator Cash asked:

How much did the Office of Women spend on staff travel in 2011-12 and to date? Provide a breakdown of travel undertaken by the type of travel and the class of travel. Please advise who undertook the travel and the purpose for which it was undertaken.

Answer:

All travel was undertaken for the purpose of supporting the business activities of the Office for Women.

In 2011-12, a total of \$135,998 was spent on staff travel of which \$74,662 was used for staff to participate in Australian delegations and international meetings. Travel expenditure to date is \$11,673.
