## **Senator Cash** asked:

Can you advise what has happened with the \$300,000 funding that was provided to the Community Credit Foundation, as part of the Community Development Financial Institution pilot?

## **Answer:**

Funding of \$300,000 was granted to Fitzroy & Carlton Community Credit Co-op to set up the Community Credit Foundation for the purposes of establishing the legal entity of the Foundation, acquiring tax deductibility status, establishing lending criteria, policies and procedures, developing a website, filming a small loan and budgeting service DVD, marketing the Community Credit Foundation and developing a financial literacy program. Independent audit reports have shown that \$220,000 of the original grant has been expended according to funding arrangements leaving an unspent amount of \$80,000 which will be returned to government.
