Senator Boyce asked:

How much was spent on printing in 2011-12? Of this amount, how much was for printing documents?

Answer:

In 2011-12, the Department spent \$1,330,541 (GST exclusive) on publishing and printing. This includes printing by the Social Security Appeals Tribunal.

The figure provided includes all centrally recorded printing, and does not incorporate any printing procured outside of the centralised process.

Information on how much of this was spent on printing documents is not readily available without the use of significant resources.
