### **Senator Moore** asked:

- 1. Can you provide the latest data on overall costs associated with the Sickness Allowance?
- 2. Can you confirm whether the Department has done any work on possible mechanisms for reducing the future costs associated with this payment?
- 3. Has the Department done any work relating to possible changes to any aspect of the current settings for the Sickness Allowance?

#### Answer:

- 1. In the 2012-13 financial year, Sickness Allowance expenditure was \$98.658 million (*DEEWR Annual Report 2013/14*).
- 2. The Department monitors all income support payments and regularly reviews their cost and effectiveness.
- 3. The Government is currently looking at Australia's system of social security to ensure that there is a balance between the incentive to work and the well-being of the individual.
