## Question:

a) How many appointments have there been since the election (7 September)?
b) What positions were filled?
c) What process was followed?
d) Are the appointments permanent or fixed-term?

## Answer:

a) The Therapeutic Goods Administration (TGA), a fully cost-recovered regulator, appointed 27 scientific, medical and administrative staff over the period 9 September to 30 November 2013. Twenty offers were made during the period 7 September to 31 October 2013. Seven offers were made during the period 1 November to 30 November 2013.
b) The scientific, medical and administrative roles filled comprised:

- 6 x APS Level 3 (4 x Clinical Trials/Special Access Scheme Officers, $1 \times$ Administrative Support Officer, $1 \times$ Records Officer)
- 3 x APS Level 4 ( $2 \times$ Executive Assistants, $1 \times$ Public Contact Officer)
- $4 \times$ APS Level 5 ( $1 \times$ Web Administrator, $1 \times$ Accounts Receivable Officer, $2 \times$ Medical Device Assessors)
- 4 x APS Level 6 (2 x Evaluators, 1 x Senior Workforce Planning Officer, 1 x Medical Device Assessor)
- 4 x Executive Level 1 ( 1 x Assistant Director, $1 \times$ Toxicologist, $1 \times$ Policy Project and Information Officer, $1 \times$ Biomedical/Software Engineer)
- 2 x Executive Level 2 ( 2 x Directors)
- $2 \times$ Medical Officer Class 4; and
- 2 x Medical Officer Class 2.
c) The appointments were made using the following processes:
- a formal merit based selection process that began before the election;
- placement of staff at level through the departmental reassignment/mobility registers;
- the TGA temporary employment register; and
- through a Recruitment Agency.
d) The appointments were for 17 permanent and 10 temporary assignments.
