The Handbook of Ministers of State Entitlements 2012 enables departments to provide relief staff for a period of up to 12 weeks to Parliamentary Offices, to cover times of staff absences. The Department of Health has provided temporary staffing including during the establishment period of ministerial offices as a result of Minister/Government changes.

As at 20 November 2013 departmental staffing in the portfolio ministerial offices for both Departmental Liaison Officer positions and to provide relief staffing of designated Members of Parliament Staff positions was as follows:
