**Question:**

Something that you could perhaps give me on notice is how the tranches of money that [Redcliffe GP Super] clinic were spent. It was not anticipated initially that it was going to cost \$13.2 million, was it? That was not the first amount of funding that was provided. If you could give me the stages of funding, that would be good.

**Answer:**

Total funding of \$12.927 million GST exclusive (\$14.22 million GST inclusive) was committed to the Redcliffe GP Super Clinic.

This comprised:

- Tranche 1 - \$5 million GST exclusive (\$5.5 million GST inclusive) in 2007-08;
- Tranche 2 - \$5 million GST exclusive (\$5.5 million GST inclusive) in 2010-11; and
- Tranche 3 - \$2.927 million GST exclusive (\$3.22 million GST inclusive) in 2011-12.
