Senator Ludwig asked:

- 1. How many ongoing staff recruited from Supplementary Budget Estimates in November 2013 to date? What classification are these staff?
- 2. How many non-ongoing positions exist or have been created from Supplementary Budget Estimates in November 2013 to date? What classification are these staff?
- 3. From Supplementary Budget Estimates in November 2013 to date, how many employees have been employed on contract and what is the average length of their employment period?

Answer:

1. From 1 November 2013 to 31 January 2014, 210 employees have been recruited to Australia Post with the following classifications:

Officers, Postal/Parcel Services Officers, Drivers, Sorters,

- 2. From 1 November 2013 to 31 January 2014, 76 fixed term positions have been created, with similar classifications to those listed above.
- 3. From 1 November 2013 to 31 January 2014, 23 staff have been employed on contract and their average length of employment has been three months.
