The National Gallery of Australia appeared before the Senate Standing Committee on Environment and Communications on 24 May 2017.

During the hearing Senator Gallagher asked me a question regarding the Modernisation Fund.

**Dr Vaughan:** 'Challenging' concerns the efficiency dividends that we have needed to take account of, and the reductions in appropriation as a result of that. As a result of the MYEFO December 2015 efficiency dividend, the total which was to come out over four years was \$3.94 million. The portfolio budget statement round in 2016-17 added to that, with a total of \$6.852 million over four years. There is, however, a mitigating aspect, which you have already heard about from other colleagues, of new funding through the government innovation program. For us that is \$1.944 million over three years.

After reading the Hansard transcript, we consider that a correction to the funding figure provided is required. The following sentence provides this correction:

Dr Vaughan: For us that is \$1.887 million over three years.

I trust this information will be of assistance to the Committee.
