# **Topic: Temporary or contract staff**

# Senator Urquhart, Anne asked:

- 1. Do NBNCo figures in public reports include temporary, non-ongoing or contract staff?
- 2. What is the total number of temporary or contract staff currently employed?
- 3. For the calendar year 2016:
  - (a) How much did NBNCo spend on temporary or contract staff?
  - (b) How many temporary or contract staff have been employed?
  - (c) How much was paid for agencies/companies to find temporary/contract staff?
  - (d) Have there been any changes to the policies/criteria that govern the appointment of contract staff?

#### **Answer:**

- 1. nbn reported headcount values in its annual report are inclusive of Permanent and Maximum (Fixed) Term Employees.
- 2. Total number of Temporary Staff Augmentation (TSA) currently employed is 884.

3.

- (a) For calendar year 2016 the total TSA spend was \$273.6m. Of that, \$186.5m was capitalised.
- (b) Closing number of TSA Resources as Dec 2016 month end was 958.
- (c) This information is commercial in confidence
- (d) Yes. In 2017, nbn centralised the procurement and management of its TSA population through a Managed Service Provider (MSP). The solution is designed to deliver cost savings of \$15m over three years through rate and margin harmonisation; process efficiencies; quality resources and management of risk. This is supported by amended Business Guidelines and Policy.
