24/3/17	Installation of electrical cabling to television and connection to aerial	Re-purposed television relocated within offices required connection to power/aerial.	\$1,650.00
31/3/17	Kettle	Broken kettle replaced in staff kitchen.	\$40.00
13/5/17	Installation of electronic blinds (includes cost of electrician to supply power to the blinds)	To reduce glare on computer screens as well as install block out blinds for a screening room.	\$14,005.20
30/5/17	2 x sandwich toasters	Old sandwich toasters (over 3 years old) were worn down with broken parts and posed an electrical risk.	\$198.00
1/6/17	Modification to lighting	Install a light switch in meeting room in order to turn off the sensor light during a screening.	\$520.00
