# Senator BUSHBY asked:

- 1005. Has the department/agency received any updated advice on how to respond to FOI requests?
- 1006. What is the total cost to the department to process FOI requests for this financial year to date (22 February 2013)?

#### 1007.

- a. How many FOI requests has the Department received for this financial year to date (22 February 2013)?
- b. How many requests have been denied and how many have been granted?
- c. Has the department failed to meet the processing times outlined in the FOI Act for any requests? If so, how many and why?
- d. Do any of these requests remain outstanding? If so, how many and why?

#### Answer:

- 1005. The Australian Prudential Regulation Authority (APRA) has received no updates on its treatment of Freedom of Information (FOI) requests since the October 2012 Supplementary Budget Estimates.
- 1006. The estimated total cost to process FOI requests for the financial year to 22 February 2013 was \$23,950.
- 1007. a. APRA received 34 FOI requests for the financial year to 22 February 2013.
  - b. For the requests finalised during the financial year to 22 February 2013:
    - 5 were granted in full;
    - 5 were granted in part; and
    - 14 were refused access.
