**Senator BUSHBY asked:**

1087. How much was spent on 2013 Graduate Training? Provide details of what training was provided, why and the estimated cost for each.

**Answer:**

1087. To end February 2013 the training provided was:

- Induction and Orientation – to welcome and induct graduates into the ABS & APS environment (Nil cost).
- Administrative Law & APS Decision Making in the ABS (1.5 sessions) – this program is held to expose all graduates to Public Sector Administration, legislation and policies pertaining to their employment (\$7 875).
- Understanding the Statistical Cycle – to introduce all graduates to ABS core business (\$5 000).
