- 1127. Could the department/agency provide a list of all grants, including ad hoc and one-off grants for this financial year to date? Please provide details of the recipients, the amount, the intended use of the grants and what locations have benefited from the grants.

  - a. How much was funding reduced for each grant?

#### **Answer:**

1127. The Australian Bureau of Statistics has paid \$16,000 in scholarship payments for the period 1 July 2012 to 22 February 2013. All payments relate to the Methodology Scholarship for students who want to pursue a career in statistical research. The successful applicant must be studying statistics for the whole year.
