### Senator BUSHBY asked:

189. How much was spent on 2013 Graduate Training? Provide details of what training was provided, why and the estimated cost for each.

#### **Answer:**

189. Graduate Training in 2013 is expected to be approximately \$21,000. Graduates also receive on the job training in rotations and internal programs and attend topic specific and needs specific training, including seminars, IT systems training, Budget training and Treasury specific Group training. This training is provided in house. We are not able to accurately estimate the cost of this training.
