Senator BUSHBY asked:

- 465. What sum did each portfolio department and agency spend on legal services for this financial year to date (22 February 2013) within the department/agency? Please provide a list of each service and costs.
- 466. What sum did each portfolio department and agency spend on legal services this financial year to date (22 February 2013) from the Australian Government Solicitor? Please provide a list of each service and costs.
- 467. What sum did each portfolio department and agency spend on legal services this financial year to date (22 February 2013) from private firms? Please provide a list of each service and costs.
- 468. What sum did each portfolio department and agency spend on legal services this financial year to date (22 February 2013) from other sources? Please provide a list of each service and costs.

Answer:

- 465. The expenditure on legal services within the ACCC for the period from 1 July 2012 to 31 January 2013 was \$5,073,838. This is comprised of staffing and associated costs for the Legal Group.
- 466. The ACCC's expenditure on legal services from the Australian Government Solicitor for the period from 1 July 2012 to 31 January 2013 was \$9,099,075. This is comprised of expenditure on Professional Service Fees in the amount of \$6,704,230 and Legal Counsel Fees of \$2,394,845.
- 467. The ACCC's expenditure on legal services from private firms for the period 1 July 2012 to 31 January 2013 was \$4,611,982. This is comprised of expenditure on Professional Service Fees in the amount of \$3,182,729 and Legal Counsel Fees of \$1,429,254.
- 468. The ACCC's expenditure on legal services from other sources for the period 1 July 2012 to 31 January 2013 was \$59,032. This is comprised of expenditure on Direct Briefed Counsel Fees.
