**Senator BUSHBY asked:**

890. How many documents (include the number of copies) have been printed this financial year to date (22 February 2013)?
- a. How many of these printed documents were also published online?

**Answer:**

890. In 2012-13 to 22 February 2013, 22,448,585 individual items have been printed. The major items produced in the period were:

<b>Item</b>	<b>Individual items</b>
Super reform campaign promotional item	900,000
TFN Instructions	2,000,000
Flyer - Payment method information leaflet	2,000,000
GST calculation worksheet	3,900,000
Flyer - TFN declaration addendum	2,620,000
Newsletter - back to business	8,983,800

These figures exclude all stationary items including envelopes and letterhead.
