Senator BUSHBY asked:

- 967. How much did each department/agency spend on hire cars this financial year to date (28 February 2013)? Provide a breakdown of each business group in each department/agency.
 - a. What are the reasons for hire car costs?

Answer:

967. In 2012-13 to 28 February 2013, the ATO (including the Australian Charities and Not for Profits Commission, the Australian Valuation Office, Australian Business Register and the Tax Practitioners Board) spent \$120,723 (excluding GST) on hire cars.

a. The ATO short-term hire vehicles contract for business use provides the same terms as fleet vehicles and are used when cost efficient. For example, travel to and from an airport where it is more cost effective than taxis, interstate travel or when a fleet vehicle is not available.
