TOPIC: Total amount of measures the Anti-Dumping Commission is providing

REFERENCE: Written Question – Senator Carr

QUESTION No.: AI-142

Can the Anti-Dumping Commission please provide an update on the total number of measures it is currently managing, with a breakdown outlining how many measures relate to steel and aluminium products; how many types of steel and aluminium products; and from what countries? In addition, what proportion of these measures apply to steel exports from China?

ANSWER

As at 28 February 2017, the Commission has the following 73 measures (including provisional measures) in place: 54 interim dumping duties, nine interim countervailing duties, nine dumping securities and one countervailing security.

As at 28 February 2017, the Commission has the following 52 measures (including provisional measures) on steel and aluminium products in place: 39 interim dumping duties, eight interim countervailing duties and five dumping securities.

These measures are on 14 different steel and two aluminium products from the following countries:

- China (15 steel and four aluminium measures)
- Finland (one steel measure)
- Indonesia (one steel measure)
- Japan (four steel measures)
- Korea (eight steel measures)
- Malaysia (three steel measures and one aluminium measure)
- Romania (one steel measure)
- Singapore (two steel measures)
- Spain (one steel measure)
- Sweden (one steel measure)
- Taiwan (six steel measures)
- Thailand (two steel measures)
- The Phillipines (one steel measure)
- Vietnam (one aluminium measure)

20.5 per cent of all measures relate to steel products exported from China and 32.6 per cent of measures on steel relate to products exported from China.
