ANSWER

1-4: Minor Gifts (e.g. chocolates, memorabilia, flowers) may be purchased in accordance with the departmental policy on gifting, which prescribes that gifts must withhold public scrutiny, promote government objectives, services or programs; and facilitate public business.

The total amount spent on gifts in the 2016 calendar year was \$1,708.37 (GST inclusive). The department does not maintain an itemised list of all gifts purchased. To do this would require an officer to manually review and extract data. Due to the time this would take, the department considers this to be an unreasonable diversion of resources.

5-6: The total amount spent on gifts in the 2016 calendar year, purchased through the department for use by Ministers was zero.
