844. The ACCC's operational guidelines for travel designate economy class as the standard class of travel within Australia. SES may travel business class, as per entitlement, but are encouraged to consider travelling in economy on flights between Sydney and Canberra or other short single leg flights. There has been a reduction in business flights.

This is in line with the Finance circular No. 2012/04 in the use of the Lowest Practical Fare (LPF) for Official Domestic Air Travel.
845. Yes. The ACCC pays the lounge membership for 21 SES employees and 8 non SES employees. Membership has been provided where staff are required to undertake significant travel. Memberships are to QANTAS or Virgin lounges. Total annual cost is \$7,877.
