Senator BUSHBY asked:

- 1131. How much was spent by each department and agency on the government (Ministers/Parliamentary Secretaries) stationery requirements in your portfolio (i.e. paper, envelopes, with compliments slips) this financial year to date (26 October 2012)?
- 1132. What are the department/agency's stationery costs for the financial year to date (26 October 2012)?
- 1133. How much was spent by each department and agency on the government (Ministers/Parliamentary Secretaries) stationery requirements in your portfolio (i.e. paper, envelopes, with compliments slips) in 2011-12?
- 1134. What were the department/agency's stationery costs for 2011-12?

Answer:

- 1131. The total spend on Ministers/Parliamentary Secretaries stationery requirements for the financial year to 31 October 2012 was \$10,399.
- 1132. The total spend on the Treasury's stationery requirements for the financial year to 31 October 2012 was \$75,540.
- 1133. The total spend on Ministers/Parliamentary Secretaries stationery requirements for the 2011-12 financial year was \$24,490.
- 1134. The total spend on the Treasury's stationery requirements for the 2011-12 financial year was \$290,651.
