- 1143. How much was spent by each department and agency on the government (Ministers/Parliamentary Secretaries) stationery requirements in your portfolio (i.e. paper, envelopes, with compliments slips) this financial year to date (26 October 2012)?
- 1144. What are the department/agency's stationery costs for the financial year to date (26 October 2012)?
- 1145. How much was spent by each department and agency on the government (Ministers/Parliamentary Secretaries) stationery requirements in your portfolio (i.e. paper, envelopes, with compliments slips) in 2011-12?
- 1146. What were the department/agency's stationery costs for 2011-12?

**Answer:**

- 1143. APRA does not pay for Ministers' or Parliamentary Secretaries' stationery requirements.
