 - a. What are the reasons for taxi costs?

Answer:

- 1583. The Australian Prudential Regulation Authority (APRA) records taxi costs as part of Domestic Local Transport costs. The cost of Domestic Local Transport for the financial year to 26 October 2012 is \$ 51,458.42.
 - a) APRA staff are expected to attend business and other meetings as part of performing their responsibilities. These are working expenses.
