Answer:

- 1587. The total cost of taxi travel for the financial year to date 1 July 2012 to 31 October 2012 is \$354,244 (exclusive of GST). All taxi travel is incurred for business purposes and is undertaken on the basis of efficient, effective, economical and ethical use of Commonwealth resources.
- 1588. The total cost of taxi travel for last financial year (1 July 2011 to 30 June 2012) was \$1,292,421 (exclusive of GST). All taxi travel is incurred for business purposes and is undertaken on the basis of efficient, effective, economical and ethical use of Commonwealth resources.
