    - ii. How many non-ongoing staff, their classification, type of work they undertake and their location
    - iii. How many contractors, their classification, type of work they undertake and their location

#### Answer:

1779.

- a. i. APRA has four full-time staff employed under terms and conditions pursuant to the Australian Prudential Regulation Authority Act 1998 within its Media and Communications team. They are:
  - Head of Media and Communications
  - Senior Communications Advisor
  - Desktop Publisher
  - Communications Advisor

Media and Communications staff's responsibilities include internal and external communications and desktop publishing of documents, such as APRA's policy and discussion papers, standards and guidance to industry. All Media and Communications staff are located in Sydney.
