**Topic: Printing Costs**

**Senator BUSHBY asked:**

1792. How much was spent on printing 2011-12? Of this amount, how much was for printing documents?
1793. How many documents (include the amount of copies) were printed in 2011-12? How many of these printed documents were also published online?
1794. Of the documents that were printed in 2011-12, where were they delivered and what was the cost?
1795. How much has been spent on printing this financial year to date (26 October 2012)? Of this amount, how much was for printing documents?
1796. How many documents (include the amount of copies) have been printed this financial year to date (26 October 2012)? How many of these printed documents were also published online?

**Answer:**

1792. In 2011-12 \$555,829 was spent on printing. \$534,491 of this amount was for printing documents.
1793. In 2011-12 212 documents were printed. The total combined copies were 153,388. 47 of these printed documents were also published online.
1794. Documents were delivered to the Treasury or directly to Parliament House and included documents such as Budget papers, Reports and Explanatory Memorandums. Delivery costs are included in the total cost at question 1792.
1795. Between 1 July 2012 and 26 October 2012, \$78,870 was spent on printing. \$78,561 of this amount was for printing documents.
1796. Between 1 July 2012 and 26 October 2012, the Treasury printed 44 documents. The total combined copies were 13,616. Two of these printed documents were also published online.
