Senator BUSHBY asked:

- 1802. How much was spent on printing 2011-12? Of this amount, how much was for printing documents?
- 1803. How many documents (include the amount of copies) were printed in 2011-12? How many of these printed documents were also published online?
- 1804. Of the documents that were printed in 2011-12, where were they delivered and what was the cost?
- 1805. How much has been spent on printing this financial year to date (26 October 2012)? Of this amount, how much was for printing documents?
- 1806. How many documents (include the amount of copies) have been printed this financial year to date (26 October 2012)? How many of these printed documents were also published online?

Answer:

- 1802. \$10,849 was spent on printing in 2011-12. \$10,687 was spent on printing documents.
- 1803. AOFM Annual Report 2010-11, 585 copies printed, an online version was published on the AOFM website.
 - Commonwealth Government Securities booklet for investors, 160 copies printed.
- 1804. AOFM Annual Report 2010-11, 97 printed copies were mailed out to a distribution list. The exact cost of this is unavailable as it cannot be extracted from the periodic payments made to Treasury's mailroom services.
 - The Commonwealth Government Securities booklet was distributed at face-to-face meetings.
- 1805. \$2,041 has been spent on printing year-to-date. This amount was used to print documents.
- 1806. Commonwealth Government Securities booklet, 130 copies printed.
