**Topic: Printing Costs (ACCC)**

**Senator BUSHBY asked:**

1812. How much was spent on printing 2011-12? Of this amount, how much was for printing documents?
1813. How many documents (include the amount of copies) were printed in 2011-12? How many of these printed documents were also published online?
1814. Of the documents that were printed in 2011-12, where were they delivered and what was the cost?
1815. How much has been spent on printing this financial year to date (26 October 2012)? Of this amount, how much was for printing documents?
1816. How many documents (include the amount of copies) have been printed this financial year to date (26 October 2012)? How many of these printed documents were also published online?

**Answer:**

1812. \$276,883. Including \$208,578 for documents.
1813. 63 documents, totalling 947,129 copies. All were published online.
1814. The majority of the ACCC's publications are distributed directly to business and consumer target audiences through the ACCC's education and engagement officers, via the ACCC's state and territory counterpart agencies, at events and by request. All publications are available electronically. 2011-12 distribution costs were \$78,169.
1815. \$71,200. Including \$57,837 on documents.
1816. 30 documents, totalling 380,220 copies. All were published online.
