- 246. The ACCC is managing staff levels down from an Average Staffing Level (ASL) of 800 in 2011-12 to an ASL of 745 in 2012-13 through a process of natural attrition.
- a. The main reasons for the staff reduction are the efficiency dividend and the need to fund an IT upgrade.
