- 633. How many FOI requests has the Department received for this financial year to date (26 October 2012)?

  - b. Do any of these requests remain outstanding? If so, how many and why?

#### **Answer:**

- 627. Yes. For the period from 3 December 2007, the following advice has been received:
  - On 30 April 2009, Senator the Hon John Faulkner, the then Cabinet Secretary, wrote to heads of agencies subject to the FOI Act outlining the government's FOI reform objectives and asking that it be made clear to FOI decision-makers that the starting point for considering FOI requests should be a presumption in favour of giving access to documents.
  - On 28 October 2010, the then Minister for Privacy and Freedom of Information, wrote to heads of agencies subject to the FOI Act to update them on progress of the reforms to freedom of information laws and seek their assistance in implementing the reforms.
