827. Has the department/agency purchased coffee machines for staff useage?

If yes, provide a list that includes the type of coffee machine, the cost, the amount, and any ongoing costs such as purchase of coffee or coffee pods and when the machine was purchased.

Answer:

- 827. Yes. A domestic cappuccino machine was purchased with Qantas Frequent Flyer points for staff use. Two Delonghi Nespresso coffee machines were purchased in June 2011 for use for hearings and meetings with external parties at a cost of \$299 each. Coffee capsules cost 68 cents each.
