839. Has the department/agency purchased coffee machines for staff usage?

If yes, provide a list that includes the type of coffee machine, the cost, the amount, and any ongoing costs such as purchase of coffee or coffee pods and when the machine was purchased.

#### 839-842.

The ATO has purchased three coffee machines:

- one coffee machine as part of the cafeteria contract in the ATO's Penrith office, which is operated by an external business
- two coffee drip machines for the Commissioner's corporate space.

The ATO has not made any purchases of coffee machines for general staff use.

The purchase of the coffee machines was funded out of the ATO's departmental appropriation for the year in which they were purchased.
