**Topic: Stationery Requirements (ATO)**

**Senator BUSHBY asked:**

- 1159. How much was spent by each department and agency on the government (Ministers/Parliamentary Secretaries) stationery requirements in your portfolio (i.e. paper, envelopes, with compliments slips) this financial year to date (26 October 2012)?
- 1160. What are the department/agency's stationery costs for the financial year to date (26 October 2012)?
- 1161. How much was spent by each department and agency on the government (Ministers/Parliamentary Secretaries) stationery requirements in your portfolio (i.e. paper, envelopes, with compliments slips) in 2011-12?
- 1162. What were the department/agency's stationery costs for 2011-12?

**Answer:**

- 1159. For 2012-13 to 31 October 2012, the ATO spent \$236 excluding GST on stationery requirements for the Treasury Portfolio Ministers.
- 1160. For 2012-13 to 31 October 2012, the ATO has spent \$0.9 million excluding GST on stationery.
- 1161. For 2011-12, the ATO spent \$1,067 excluding GST on stationery requirements for the Treasury Portfolio Ministers.
- 1162. For 2011-12, the ATO spent \$3.5 million excluding GST on stationery.
