Senator BUSHBY asked:

- 1691. Provide details of any update of the department/agency electricity purchasing agreement if there has been a change since Budget Estimates 2011-12 (May 2012).
- 1692. What are the department/agency electricity costs for 2011-12?
- 1693. What are the department/agency electricity costs for this financial year to date?

Answer:

1691. The ATO has contractual agreements in place for sites where the ATO occupies more than 2,000 square metres. These agreements cover the provision of electricity.

Sites in Western Australian and the Northern Territory are not covered by contracts. In those sites, electricity is sourced by the building owner as per lease obligations.

The ATO's purchasing agreements are as follows:
