- 1399. For the 2012-13 financial year to date (26 October 2012) \$101,010.30 has been spent. Year to date there has been a total of 2164 places that have been attended at an average cost per participant of \$46.68. For a breakdown of course type and participant numbers refer to the table below:

For the 2012-13 financial year to date ASIC has provided study reimbursement to 7 staff at a cost of \$14,067, which is an average cost of \$2,009 per student. (There are 102 approved students for this financial year to date with an estimated total financial liability of \$254,903, which is an average cost of \$2499 per student but only 7 have received reimbursement to date.)

A total of 89 staff have accessed study leave with 327 study leave days taken during this period, at an average of 3.6 days per person.

For the 2011-12 financial year ASIC has provided study reimbursement to 155 staff at a cost of \$483,589, which is an average cost of \$3120 per student. (As per 2012-13 Budget Estimates May 2012, 188 staff were approved at a cost of \$510,265, which is an average cost of \$2,714 per student, however actual reimbursements claimed were less than allocated.)

A total of 171 staff have accessed study leave with 884 study leave days taken during this period, at an average of 5.2 days per person.
