Studies into Youth Unemployment

Question

Has the Department conducted or commissioned – or is the Department aware of – any studies into the most effective ways to address youth unemployment and improve transitions? Can the Department provide a list of these studies? And if they have been commissioned or conducted by the Department, can the Department provide a copy of the study?

Answer

The department commissioned a report by Professor Richard Sweet, of Sweet Group Pty Ltd, to investigate the ways in which OECD countries support unemployed and inactive youth. The report was commissioned by the previous government, completed in November 2012 and can be found at <u>Attachment A</u>.
