Question

FWBC - State of the Service survey - Incidents of bullying

Senator CAMERON: Your State of the service agency survey says one employee faced a code of conduct investigation for bullying. How many individual incidents of bullying were involved?

Mr O'Keeffe: I would need to take that on notice.

Answer

The question in the State of the Service survey asks how many of the employees reported in question 1 (employees subject to an investigation into a suspected breach of the APS Code of Conduct) were investigated for bullying and harassment. One employee was investigated for alleged breaches of the APS Code of Conduct, section 13 (3) An APS employee, when acting in the connection with APS employment, must treat everyone with respect and courtesy, and without harassment. This related to one individual incident.
