#### Answer

The following table provides a breakdown, by exemption category, of Youth Allowance (Other) recipients with an exemption from mutual obligation requirements as at end December 2015. There were 108,643 Youth Allowance (Other) recipients with mutual obligation requirements as at end December 2015.
