Question

Corporate cars

Since the change of Prime Minister on 14 September, 2015:

Answer

The Department does not own any corporate vehicles.

The Department leases 25 corporate vehicles for its own operations. The vehicles are located in Canberra and in State Offices. The vehicles are used to enable the department's staff to attend to official business. Between 14 September 2015 to 31 January 2016 the lease costs for each car ranged from \$1,825.59 to \$4,453.76. The kilometres travelled ranged from 135 to 6,962.

In addition, the Department shares with the Department of Education and Training the cost of 10 cars leased by the Shared Services Centre. The vehicles are located in Canberra and in State Offices. The vehicles are used for the transport of the departmental equipment, supplies and correspondence, and to enable Shared Services Centre staff to attend official business. Between 14 September 2015 to 31 January 2016 the lease costs for each car ranged from \$2,773.88 to \$3,716.37. The kilometres travelled ranged from 360 to 5,417.
