Question

Contracts for temporary staff

Since the change of Prime Minister on 14 September, 2015:

- 1. How much did the department/agency spend on temporary or contract staff?
- 2. How many temporary or contract staff have been employed?
- 3. What is the total number of temporary or contract staff currently employed?
- 4. How much was paid for agencies/companies to find temporary/contract staff?
- 5. Have there been any changes to the policies/criteria that govern the appointment of contract staff?

Answer

The department captures data as at the end of each month.

Between 1 September 2015 and 31 January 2016 the department engaged 66 non-ongoing employees under the Public Service Act 1999. As at 31 January 2016 the Department employed a total of 88 non-ongoing employees.

Decisions and budgets relating to the engagement of non-ongoing employees and third party contractors are devolved to line areas in the department. As such manually collating the total number of contractors and expenditure on non-ongoing employees and contractors would involve an unreasonable diversion of departmental resources.

Since 14 September 2015 there have been no changes to the policies/criteria that govern the appointment of contract staff.
