Question

SWA - Workplace Assessments

Since the change of Prime Minister on 14 September, 2015:

- 1. How much has been spent on workplace ergonomic assessments?
- 1. List each item of expenditure and cost
- 2. Have any assessments, not related to an existing disability, resulted in changes to workplace equipment or set up?
- 3. If so, list each item of expenditure and cost related to those changes

Answer

- 1. From 14 September 2015 to 31 January 2016, Safe Work Australia has spent \$20 896.73 on workplace ergonomics assessments.
- 1. Twenty one individual workplace assessments addressing specific issues: \$12 471.73, and 92 general assessments conducted due to relocation to new premises: \$8 424.90.
