## **FWC - Existing Resources Program**

Since the change of Prime Minister on 14 September, 2015:

- 1. How many projects, work, programs or other tasks has the department started as a consequence of government policies or priorities that are required to be funded 'within existing resources'?
- 2. List each
- 3. List the staffing assigned to each task
- 4. What is the nominal total salary cost of the officers assigned to the project?
- 5. What resources or equipment has been assigned to the project?

## **Answer**

- 1-2. By letter dated 22 December 2015 the Trade Union Royal Commission advised the Fair Work Commission (FWC) that it was referring a number of matters to it for investigation. The referrals relate to potential regulatory contraventions by trade unions and their officials and cover thirteen (13) individuals and a separate entity. A number of other matters have also been referred to the General Manager by the Trade Union Royal Commission.
- 3-5. An assessment of the resources required for this work is underway, however no estimate can be provided at this time.
