#### **Question:**

1. What is the relationship between the new Indigenous Advancement Strategy and the Closing the Gap framework?

- 2. According to the 2014-15 Portfolio Budget Statement for the Department of Prime Minister and Cabinet, the Indigenous Advancement Strategy comes into effect on 1 July 2014 and will be rolled out over the next 12 months.
- a. Could the department provide details of how existing programmes will be transitioned into the five new streams?
- b. Once the five new streams come into effect on 1 July 2014, will all existing programmes currently on transitional funding agreements be allocated to one of the five new programme streams?
- c. Could the Department provide a list of programmes as they will be organised under each of the five new programmes?
- d. How has the department determined the reallocation of funding into the five new programmes? What was the process involved in the reallocation of programme funding?
- e. How have funding agreements been mapped to the new programme structure where the activities cross over more than one of the new programme streams?
- 3. The Indigenous Advancement Strategy will begin on 1 July 2014. What tasks must be completed by 1 July 2014 in order to launch the Strategy?

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#### **Answer:**

1. Closing the Gap is a commitment by all Australian governments to improve the lives of Indigenous Australians. The Prime Minister reports annually to the House of Representatives on progress in Closing the Gap for the previous year.

The Indigenous Advancement Strategy is the new streamlined structure for Indigenous affairs activities managed through the Department of the Prime Minister and Cabinet. The new arrangements will provide an opportunity for practical engagement with Indigenous Australians, service providers, business and government to ensure solutions are tailored to local needs and directly contribute to the Closing the Gap targets.

2. and 3. The Department intends to put in place grant selection processes in 2014-15 for grant activities under the new Indigenous Advancement Strategy. Further information will be provided to service providers about this process in due course. Transition arrangements have been put in place, including extensions of existing contracts for six or 12 months that were due to cease on 30 June 2014, to ensure service providers can continue to provide important services on the ground and have time to adjust to the new arrangements.

Funding for each of the five Indigenous Advancement Strategy programmes was determined as part of the Budget process.

As part of the current transition process, individual grant activities have been mapped to the new programme structure based on the types of outcomes they are delivering and how these align to the outcomes being sought under each of the five new programmes. Some programmes may attract multiple stream funding opportunities.

The following table broadly summarises how existing programmes and activities have been mapped to the new Indigenous Advancement Strategy streams. It should be noted that there is not always a direct one-on-one correlation of a programme to a new Indigenous Advancement Strategy programme.
