Answer:

1. Yes, work has commenced. AusTender provides centralised publication of Commonwealth Government business opportunities, annual procurement plans, multiuse lists and contracts awarded. The AusTender platform will be used to develop the grants system. The project to build grants.gov.au is currently in its scoping phase.

Resource Management Branch is leading the scoping phase with technical input from Procurement Policy Branch.

Finance received funding in the 2013-14 Budget to develop a web based whole-of-government grants registration, application and reporting system. No additional financial resources are required.
