On 11 November 2013, the Department of Finance launched a data request site (datagovau.ideascale.com) using the *ideascale* ideation platform. As at 11 December 2013, there have been 33 requests for specific datasets. Finance is working with the relevant agencies to evaluate the possibility of making the requested datasets available on data.gov.au.
