

SENATE STANDING COMMITTEE ON LEGAL AND CONSTITUTIONAL AFFAIRS
ATTORNEY-GENERAL'S DEPARTMENT

Question No. 152

Senator Humphries asked the following question at the hearing on 24 May 2012:

- a) For departments/agencies that provide mobile phones to Ministers and/or Parliamentary Secretaries and/or their offices, what type of mobile phone is provided and the costs.
- b) For departments/agencies that provide electronic equipment to Ministers and/or Parliamentary Secretaries and/or their offices, what are the ongoing costs for this financial year to date? What were the running costs for 2009-10 and 2010-11?
- c) Is electronic equipment (such as iPad, laptop, wireless card, Vasco token, Blackberry, mobile phone (list type if relevant), thumb drive (not an inclusive list)) provided to department/agency staff? If yes provide details of what is provided, the purchase cost, the ongoing cost and a breakdown of what staff and staff classification receives it.

Please update if there have been any changes since Additional Estimates 2011-12 (February 2012):

- d) Does the department/agency provide their Ministers and/or Parliamentary Secretaries and/or their offices with any electronic equipment? If yes, provide details of what is provided, the cost and to whom it is provided.

The answer to the honourable senator's question is as follows:

- a) The Attorney-General's Department provides Blackberry Bold 9780 and 9800 model devices to Ministers and their staff as required. The total purchase price of the current suite of Blackberries is \$13,516 (based on cost at time of purchase).
- b) Costs are not available for the period 1 July 2011 - 24 May 2012. Recorded costs incurred for the period 1 July 2011 to 30 June 2012 are detailed below and are:
 - i. \$77,337 in call costs, and
 - ii. \$26,400 in service/support costs.

Approximate running costs for prior years were:

2009-10: \$94,131 call costs.

2010-11: \$97,977 call costs.

Departmental support costs are not available for 2009-12 and 2010-11. Note that due to significant changes to the portfolio's Ministerial structure over this period, costs are not directly comparable across years.

- c) The Attorney-General's Department and portfolio Agencies provides various standard items of personal electronic equipment to staff members as necessary including:
 - Desktop PC (including monitors)
 - Laptop, Citrix token, internet dongle
 - Blackberry devices

- iPad or iPhone device (SES only)
- Mobile phone
- Telstra wireless 4G/3G internet 'dongle'
- Bluetooth headset/car speaker
- Desktop scanner or printer
- RSA Token
- Thumb drives

These items are provided to staff for the purposes of undertaking normal duties. A breakdown of costs and staff classifications is not readily available.

d) For privacy reasons the Department does not release details of individual equipment assignments. However, in summary the Department provides the following equipment to the Minister's offices. Note: four Blackberries used by the Minister's staff were transferred from the Department of Health. While AGD currently supports these devices, it did not purchase them.
