Dear Senator Heffernan

Having reviewed the proof Hansard of the Budget Estimates hearing conducted by the Senate and Rural Regional Affairs and Transport Legislation Committee on Tuesday 26 May 2015, I wish to make the following correction:

The correction relates to my response to a question from Senator Cameron. The relevant dialogue is on page 42 of the proof Hansard.

Senator Colbeck: I was reflecting on some of the conversations over the last 24 hours.

Mr Rayns: Tier 1 is where there has been a recent full, quantitative stock assessment. A good example of that is the small pelagic fishery census of the eastern jack mackerel stock. There was a fresh survey done, there was a new assessment undertaken, a new harbour harvest strategy applied, and a result came out of that in terms of a catch level. Tier 2 is where the data is ageing. So it may be five years or older, or it may be that the type of assessment done is not as good as a daily egg production method, which is a type of assessment. A good example of that is that, this year, we used an ecosystem model, called Atlantis, that, while it is well proven nationally and internationally, it is a tool to help assess the health of the egg system ecosystem and the fish stocks in it. The reality is that it is not as good as a DEPM and it is relegated to that tier 2 level. At tier 2 we drop the harvest rates quite dramatically, often to half of what a tier 1 rate would be. You may see the harvest rate at tier 1.

I wish to advise the Committee that I mistakenly referred to the small pelagic fishery survey as the small pelagic fishery census. The correct response should read:
