Senator Fierravanti-Wells asked:

On a state by state level, what funding are the hospitals currently receiving to facilitate donation per year?

Answer:

Hospitals are currently provided funding to facilitate organ and tissue donations per year though State and Territory funding agreements (STFA). The agreements provide funds for the employment of hospital based specialist doctors and nurses of organ and tissue donation.

In addition, hospitals receive Organ Donation Hospital Support Funding (ODHSF) to assist with costs associated with organ donation by deceased donors (see E11- 333).

The table below identifies the available funding for 2010-11.
